WNIX is located in Springfield Vermont (pop. approx: 9,000), which to my knowledge was not named after Springfield, Mass. WNIX went on the air for the first time in May of this year and conducts frequency checks on the last Tuesday of every month from 12:00-12:15AM Eastern Standard Time. You are correct in your assumption that we are affiliated with WTWN and WIKE. The three stations are operated as a group known as the North Country Stations of Vermont. I am sorry I cannot comply with your request for a coverage map as none are available as yet.
