Boy!...Do I have egg on my face on this one! November 12th you DXed me and I'm just getting around to answering! Petition to deny my license! Seriously, I was just cleaning off my desk and came across your letter, unanswered, and thought I ought to respond.


Yes we are a powerful 5-KW station on the Canadian clear channel of 1070. That's the good news. The bad news is that we are a daytimer. Can't put any power toward that border at night because of CBA in Monkton, New Brunswick.

Our transmitter is an old, but modified, Gates BC-5-P-2. Solid state rectifiers, audio driver section bypassed and driven by a solid state Crown D-75 amp, etc. A real "honey" of a machine. We actually replaced a Gates BC-5-H that was in terrible disrepair with this one in March of 1995. We bought it from Armstrong Transmitters in Marcellus New York, but it came out of WINA in Charlottesville, VA. Can you imagine what the odds are against finding a 35 year old 5-kw transmitter that just happened to be tuned to 1070!

Anyway, we confirm your listenership to WZBZ on November 7th, 1996 between 4PM and 4:30PM

I spent years in Boston radio as you probably know. 1971-1975 at WJDA, Quincy, 1973-1980 at WJIB-FM, 1980-1985 at WEEI as a News anchor, and 1989-1993 as a Talkshow Host at WHDH. Lived in Hingham for 25 years. Get me out of here, I want to go home! Also helped Don Moore put WOCN-FM on the air in Hyannis in spring-summer of 1994.
