Dear Mr. Cooper:

I am writing in response to your May 29th letter to Marvin Easley whom I replaced as General Manager of WLBF in January after his untimely death from a heart attack last September. Marvin would have been very interested in the phenomenon you described in your letter due to his love for and involvement in both professional and amateur radio. He would have responded with more technical expertise than I, I'm sure, but I trust my answer will suffice, nonetheless.

It appears that you may, indeed, have caught part of our broadcast on Sunday, May 27th, 1990. The preacher you heard would have been Dr. William Brownson, a professor at Western Theological Seminary in Holland, MI, whose program is sent to us via satellite Spacenet IIIR by the Moody Broadcasting Network in Chicago, IL. We rebroadcast the signal at 100kw with a Shively 6-bay antenna at 600 feet from Montgomery to (usually!) approximately a 70-mile radius incorporating most of south-central Alabama.

Thank you for your interesting letter. I will now be able to report to our Board that our signal is reaching farther than we ever thought it would! If you ever make it down to Alabama, please stop by the station--I'd be glad to give you a tour.
