Dear Ernest,

I must say that I was very impressed with your letter dated September 27, 1981. First, let me tell you a little about my background. I first went on the air in August of 1980 at radio station WWCO-A.M. 1240 in Waterbury, Connecticut. My shift included running taped broadcasts, engineering a Spanish program (live) and going on air as a Disc Jockey for a top 40 format, Sunday nights.


As you probably know, in radio, job security is not one of the finer points, and in June of this year I lost my job at "CO" due to a programming change. I was fortunate enough to land a job at WCCC-F.M. on August 9, 1981.

The broadcast you heard on August 16, 1981 was a show in which I took over at 1:30 a.m. On the night of September 27, 1981 you did in fact hear my broadcast. We broadcast 24 hours a day on 106.9 F.M. (50,000 Watts) and daytime on 1290 A.M. (500 Watts).
