Dear Ernest,

Your reception report came as quite a surprise to me. I am a DXer myself and have been chief engineer of WWUH for almost six years. Your report is the first I have received! This is not because our signal doesn't get out very far, but because DXers don't send out as many reports as they used to. What a pleasure to receive your report.

I'm glad you were able to hear us with WUNH on the air, a fact that speaks highly of your Realistic STA-52. Our normal coverage in your general direction goes only as far as the Rhode Island line, so your reception is really special.


Our transmitter is located in Avon on Avon Mountain, and operates with an effective radiated power of 1,000 watts, with an antenna height of 520 feet above average terrain. The transmitter is a Harris FM-2.5K which uses a EIMAC 5CX1500A final tube. The antenna is also by Harris, and consists of three bays, side mounted on a 112 foot tower. Studio equipment includes Technics SP-10D turntables with Audio Technica arms and Stanton cartridges. Consoles are Autogram with Sennheisser and E-V microphones. The stereo generator is a Harris MSP-90 which feeds a Moseley PCL-606C studio to transmitter link operating on 947.0 MHz (call sign is WAC-258). We generally use no audio processing on the air, but a Harris peak limiter is in the chain to prevent overmodulation.

I am also a member of the WTFDA and the NRC as well as the Longwave Club of America. As I am chief of three other stations in Hartford, I don't get much time to DX, but it is lots of fun.

WWUH is also an all volunteer station; everyone who works here does so because they enjoy working with radio. The entire staff get a kick out of the fact that you could hear us in Provincetown.

Thanks Ernest for your report, you may indeed consider this letter as verification of your reception of WWUH on September 19th, 1984 at 1008 EDT. If you should hear us again, please let us know (send a tape if possible, we will return same). Take care and good DX.
