Please accept my humble apology for sending you the wrong verification card for your original report. I was working on 2 QSL reports simultaneously and consequently mixed them up. Therefore, I certainly do not think you are picky, for it was my mistake.

The information you heard was on the CBAF-6 (formerly CBAF-21) station at a frequency of 107.5. This is a French Radio Station broadcast from Middleton, Nova Scotia. The radiated power is 25 kw (kilowatts) and the transmitted power is only 5 kw, so it is a very weak signal.

I'm amazed at how many stations you have been able to pick up over the years.

I hope this verification and information is useful, and I do apologize once again.
