Let me first of all thank you for your interesting correspondence of March 31 which I received this morning.

This will confirm your reception of our FM Stereo rebroadcasting station at 93.5 MHz on Sunday March 30, 1986.


CJLS presently operates the AM Transmitter at 1340 kHz at 5,000 watts day and 4,000 watts night serving Yarmouth County and rebroadcasts on 93.5 FM Stereo to Digby County (and other places apparently). It emits 3,000 watts e.r.p. and on 96.3 FM Stereo to Shelburne County with 5,500 watts e.r.p. This allows us to broadcast to all of southwestern Nova Scotia as you can see from the enclosed coverage map.

This will confirm also that the signature you have on the old verification card is indeed Laurie Smith, the founder of CJLS and its operator until his death in 1958. The station operated from the Grand Hotel until about 1939 and moved to other locations. It was a family business until 1969 when Radio CJLS Limited bought the assets and put in place an entire new operation. The expansion with the rebroadcasters happened in November of 1984.

CJLS operates from 5.25a to 1.12a on all three stations.

I hope this addresses your concerns and it was good to hear from you.
