Dear Mr. Cooper,


It was a most pleasant surprise when your letter of June 30 was handed to me a couple of mornings ago. I can indeed confirm your reception of CHAS-FM the morning of June 27, 1988.

We, just last fall, installed new transmitting equipment which increased our output by some 600%. As I say though your reception of our station is a rather pleasant surprise. It made an interesting conversation piece on my program the other morning.

Our station is an easy listening station. That could include just about anything from Frank Sinatra to Whitney Houston to Jim Reeves to Barbra Streisand. I host a classical music program twice a week myself, Thursday and Friday at 10:00 pm, called "Masters of Music". We also have a jazz show every Sunday at 6:00 pm called "Just Jazz". This show came about some 15 years ago and was originally hosted by Ian Weatherston, who I understand went on to host a similar show on a Massachusetts station about 10 years ago.
