After checking station records and audio logging, I am pleased to verify your reception of WMZQ-AM on Friday February 5, 1988 and, particularly exciting, your reception of WMZQ-FM on October 17, 1987.


WMZQ-AM is a 24hr., 5KW, DA-2 radio station. The daytime pattern is a figure "8" formed by three "in-line" towers with coverage to the east and west. At night we switch to a four tower array and throw a single lobe to the east with some fattening to the north and south. We use the 100% solid state Nautel transmitter and transmit in AM stereo using the Motorola system.

WMZQ-FM is a class "B" radio station transmitting with 50KW of power at an antenna height of 500 feet. We use a CCA 20,000D transmitter and a Shively, six bay antenna.

WMZQ AM/FM is owned by Viacom Broadcasting which is based in New York. Perhaps you've DXed our sister FM in New York, WLTW. At the time of your October DX, we had already begun full time simulcasting of the AM and FM which we continue to do. Up until four years ago, WMZQ-AM was under different ownership and under the call of WEAM.

Thank you for your reception report and I apologize for the long delay in responding to it. Happy DXing!
