Dear Mr. Cooper,

It was nice to hear from you and be able to confirm your reception of WMIE-FM. Your report is accurate in all its particulars.

The studios are still at the location you described, which is West King Street/S.R.520 in Cocoa. We did have a C.P. for 770 Khz, but have decided not to pursue it at this time and will remain on 1510 am. Our FM, which you heard, is at 91.5 and will remain there, though we are considering either raising our antenna or moving the tower site.


The FM tower is located about two miles inland from the Indian River, a salt water river (our AM tower is in the river--great grounding!), and about ten+ miles from the ocean.

Also along the coast we have WCNO FM, 89.9, in Palm City, just north of West Palm Beach. It is 100,000 watts, whereas WMIE 91.5 is 20,000. And we just put a new station on the air along the coast in Ft. Pierce at 91.1, with the call WJFP FM. This is a 6,000 watt station, and has only been on the air a week.

Our most distant DX so far has been from the AM, with a listener in Norway.

Congratulations on pulling in the FM signal of WMIE. By the way, we are on until 9:30 pm Monday thru Friday, should conditions be prime during the after sunset hours. WCNO is on until 10:00 pm weeknights. WJFP is on until midnight every night.
