This letter is to confirm your reception of WPAP FM June 14, 1992. We are most happy that you took the time to write to us to report the reception.

WPAP FM transmits with an output power of 100,000 watts ERP. We use a Continental 35 KW transmitter. Transmitter output power is 26.2 KW, loaded into an 8 bay ERI antenna using 4 inch rigid line. Antenna height is 960 feet above average terrain.

I am quite familiar with your area of the country, having lived in the Bay State some years ago. I graduated from Boston Univ. in 1962. At the time, I was living in Stoneham. So it is always good to hear from someone still living on my old stomping grounds.

If you are ever in our area, please look us up. Panama City is a resort city, being right on the water. People come here from everywhere to vacation in the sommer. It is quite a pretty area.
