We have just received your letter and found it very interesting. I have been in radio off and on since 1981 and have heard of these "Skips" but had never actually heard one.

The notations that you made indeed were broadcast on our station. The times that you had listed indicate that you are in the Eastern time zone (we are in the Central).

At 4:45, you heard "CAMPMEETING TIME" with Glen Lowery pastor of Pace Assembly of God Church located at 3948 Hwy 90 Pace, Florida, 32570. THE BISHOPS were Auburn Assembly of God Church in Crestview. The legal ID that you heard was "WTJT Crestview-Baker 90.1 FM".


We carry the USA Network News broadcast on satellite from Dallas, Texas. The DJ that you heard was Jim Harkins from Fort Walton Beach, Florida. He DOES NOT like to receive phone calls during the five minutes that the news is on because we have to cut out their commercials and replace them with our public service announcements. Also, his little saying is ". . . on the Jesus Coast."

I gave you the above information to verify that you did indeed hear WTJT on Thursday, May 31, 1990. Unfortunately, I do not have a coverage map that I can send you but as soon as we get one, I'll be more than glad to send you one.

WTJT is located in the Florida Panhandle, approximately 50 miles east of Pensacola, FL, and 150 miles west of Tallahassee, FL.

Thanks for your letter and the brochure on your station. Be sure to keep up your work as a volunteer DJ. Volunteers are very important in public radio as we have about six or seven volunteers along with two paid employees that put in time at WTJT.

May God richly bless you in your work and stay in touch as the opportunity arises.
