
Dear Mr. Cooper,

This is to confirm your reception of KCCK-FM's signal the night of August 3, 1981 between 8:08 p.m. and 8:11 p.m., C.D.T. KCCK-FM operates on a frequency of 88.3 MHz with 10,000 watts E.R.P. horizontally and vertically polarized from a 400 foot tower. Tower and transmitter located 1,000 feet south of Linn Hall on the Kirkwood Community College campus in extreme SW Cedar Rapids. Any reception difficulty in our local coverage area the night of August 3, 1981 has not been reported.
