Dear Ernest,

A thousand apologies for not responding to your signal report sooner than this. I won't bother you with the excuses that I have, suffice it to say that I have been very, very busy. Besides being the chief engineer at WBGL, I am also a ham (KB9JR) and know what it is like to wait for QSL's and/or confirmation of signal reports.

You have all the information correct as far as the signal and the programming that you heard.

WBGL is a Christian broadcaster-part of a network which includes WIBI in Carlinville, Il. and WCIC in Pekin/Peoria, Il. WBGL operates a Harris FM-10K transmitter with a power output of 7.3 KW into an FM6-LE 6 bay circularly polarized antenna at a height of 500 ft. which results in an effective radiated power of 20,000 watts. Our transmitter is located one mile north and four miles east of Urbana, Il. The terrain here is very flat and as a result, our listening area (normally!) covers about a sixty mile radius.

I hope that this information is useful to you, Ernest. I will try to include a post card in the envelope when I mail this report to you and would appreciate it if you would send it back to me so that I will know that you did receive this.
