Dear Mr. Cooper,

Thank you for your reception report. Your reported schedule of our programming is correct. It is a pleasure to hear that we are "getting out" as we enjoy sharing our Hoosier hospitality in any way we can.

You probably know a great deal about our station, but you may not know that we transmit from a four section 37CP-4 Collins antenna which is mounted on a tower at 500' AGL, 1335' ASL. The antenna is polarized both horizontally and vertically. We radiate 20KW ERP with 11.5 KW out of the transmitter. The transmitter is a CCA FM-27500E which has the capability of putting out 50 KW ERP from our antenna. We have an aux transmitter located at our down town studio which has a capability of putting out 2 KW ERP.

Since we are directly in the tornado belt, we operate our own radar system to keep our listeners advised of weather conditions. Our programming format is completely country, seven days a week, 24 hours a day.

It certainly was nice to make your acquaintance. Hope you will "keep your ears on" and just maybe our signals will cross again.
