Dear Mr. Cooper,

Thank you for your letter of September 27. KRPS is a very new station--we signed on April 29 of this year--so your first letter apparently got lost in the start-up shuffle. My apologies.

Part of your log is correct. The 8:59 promo and ID on Karl Haas is correct, as is Kathryn Loomans at 9:06. I don't believe the harp-orchestra concerto was KRPS, though, because we carry a portion of National Public Radio's "Morning Edition," a talk program, from 8:50-8:59. I'm pretty sure that the "Porgy and Bess" music was not ours, either, since we would have joined Kathryn Loomans at the top of the hour. She would have introduced a short music segment that would have run from 9:01-9:06, then reintroduced herself at 9:06 as you have indicated.

I hope this provides the documentation you need. I will forward your inquiry about a Pittsburg State University marching band record or tape to the music department. I'm not sure if they have recordings or not.
