Thank you for listening to WBCS! I was fascinated to hear about your achievements in pulling in FM stations from across North America. I also find your reception report to be quite accurate.

I can tell you a bit about our station: we have been playing country music for a year and a half, the format started with our purchase of the former jazz station WCDJ from Emmis Broadcasting. We went on the air with WBCS during the first week of May, 1993, debuting with Alabama's "Here We Are", followed by Sawyer Brown's "Trouble on the Line" (a sly nod to our country competition.)

We broadcast with 50,000 watts ERP from the Sconnix tower in Newton, Massachusetts (near 128.) We get phone calls from listeners from all six New England states. We pride our self in using state-of-the-art equipment including a B.E. transmitter and a digital Optimod.
