I am pleased to verify your DX reception of Stereo 91.5/WBIM-FM at 12:23 a.m. E.D.T. on May 22, 1983. We are owned and operated by the Student Union of Bridgewater State College and transmit at a frequency of 91.5 MHz with an effective radiated power of 180 watts at a height above average terrain of 71 feet.

We use a Versa-Count exciter running at 4 watts into a Versa-Count 150 watt RF Amplifier fed to our circularly polarized Cetec antenna with the major lobe of our signal based just about 30 miles west of you.

Your letter is of considerable interest to me, being an avid AM, FM and TV DX'er such as myself. If possible, I wish you could send me info on how to join the NRC. (I do have a 1978 N.R.C. Domestic Log.)
