This letter is to confirm your reception of WFXR on Sunday 9/24/89 between 9:50AM and 12:10PM EDT. WFXR is a 3,000 watt commercial station at 93.5FM.

I saw a survey conducted in the Providence, R.I. market regarding listenership between 1AM and 5AM. The survey showed a full third of the population is awake and active at some time during those hours. We think people do listen overnight and that it's worth the operational cost to stay on the air. Sorry about messing up your overnight reception.
