Dear Ernest,

This is to verify your reception report of our station on September 17, 1992. I was very impressed to see that you had received our station some 500 miles or so away - the tropospheric ducting conditions must have been very good that morning. WHVY currently is licensed to broadcast at a power of 3 kW, however we are in the process of up-grading to a 6 kW Class A station, which should be completed by December 1992. Our transmitter site is located near the town of Grasonville, on Maryland's Eastern Shore, and our studios are located in downtown Annapolis, Md. We have a microwave link across the Chesapeake Bay which "connects" our audio feed (and control data) from the studio to our transmitter site. Our program format is currently "Pure Rock" - an AOR format with a slightly harder edge. Our play list includes "Guns and Roses", "Metallica", "AC/DC", "Aerosmith", "Pearl Jam", and "Rush", "Van Halen", etc.
