Dear Mr. Cooper:

This is to confirm your report of reception of WJHU, Baltimore on Tuesday, June 21, 1994 between the hours of 0232 and 0404. I must say I was surprised that our signal could be received at such a distance, even considering signal skip.

WJHU operates 24 hours a day at an Effective Radiated Power of 10,000 Watts at a frequency of 88.1 MHz. We are licensed to the Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland. Our programming includes classical music, jazz, public affairs call-in shows and news from National Public Radio, our affiliated network.

On Tuesday mornings, the voice on the air was that of Ms. Dawn Culbertson, host of the renaissance music program, "Exploring Early Music." Ms. Culbertson is the overnight announcer Monday through Friday, with her show airing Tuesdays only.

WJHU is supported by listener contributions as well as local businesses and foundation grants, which are usually program-specific.

I am including a copy of our 1mV (60 dBu) coverage map. Good luck on your continued DX hobby and I appreciate your interest in our broadcast.
