This letter will confirm your reception of WMME-FM 92.3 on Sunday, August 20, 1995 from 0757 to 0825 EDT.

Your program details were very accurate.

WMME-FM broadcasts with an ERP of 50kw with antenna 152 meters above average terrain. N 44° 20' 07" W 69° 41' 01"

Here in Central Maine, we have noticed the ducting effect in hot Summer weather on Cape Cod stations, notably WKPE (overriding Bangor and Kennebunkport stations on 104.7), WCOD, WCIB, and also WPLM from Plymouth. We have caught WPRO-FM 92.3 as far north as Farmington, ME when WMME-FM was knocked off the air by a power failure on a July afternoon. I have also received WRZE on a warm spring morning in Rocky Hill, CT.

We have not received the WEBB reception report you referred to.

Good luck with your DXing. Do people still say 73's?
