Please consider this letter official verification of your reception report dated 6/6/91. It was a pleasant surprise to receive your report, as I am a neophyte DXer myself (less than a year), and have only recently considered mailing out verification reports of my own. It was very helpful to see what a report from an experienced DXer looks like.

WSTG-FM (STAR 94.3) is actually the old WYJY-FM. We were granted a permit to increase our output from 3000 to 25,000 watts earlier in the year, and with the power increase came a change of calls and some fine-tuning of our adult-contemporary format. I have enclosed a coverage map to show you exactly how far our new signal reaches.

Our studios (which we share with our sister-station, WIDE-AM, 1400 kHz) are located in Biddeford and our transmitter is approximately six miles away in neighboring Saco.
