Good Morning, Mr. Cooper!

Thank you for letting us know of your reception of our signal on November 5, 1981. Judging by what you have told us I must say you were listening to WWMR, 96.3 FM, Rumford, Maine.

Perhaps the reason you had not heard us before is that on October 26 we went on the air with a new antenna and a new transmitting site. Prior to that change we operated on Channel 242 with an ERP of 30 kw at an antenna height above average terrain of 36 feet.

Our new transmitting facility is located on Black Mountain in Rumford. We have a new 295 foot tower with a 10 bay CCA FM antenna side mounted; fed by a CCA FM-10,000 DS, 10 kw transmitter.

The co-ordinates of our new facility are North 44,34,56; WEST 70,37,59. This puts us in a spot 2,540 feet above sea level.

By the way WRUM is still on the air at 790 with 1000 watts.

Thank you again, Mr. Cooper, for your report.
