Being a part-time DX hobbyist, I was particularly pleased to hear of your reception report in the Cape Cod area--to the best of my knowledge, the most distant response we've had.


This letter is to confirm your reception report of Sunday, July 9, 1989. I've enclosed a copy of our program magazine which verifies the programming you listed.

You're correct in stating that you heard exact programming on both 90.5 and 90.7, as well as 91.1 and 91.7. All four stations are part of the Minnesota Public Radio network and all would have been broadcasting the same programming at that time. The 91.1 was most likely KSJN, St.Paul/Mpls, while the 91.7 was most likely KLSE, Rochester. However, we also have stations at 91.1 in Fargo/Moorhead (northwest MN) and 91.7 at Pipestone (southwest MN). Still given the closer proximity of Rochester, St.Peter and St.Paul, I'd guess it was the first two stations you heard.

As for the 90.7, KBPR, Brainerd, is one of our newest additions to the network, having been on the air only about a year. My letter may also suffice as evidence that you did, indeed, receive that station as well. Here again, programming would have been identical to ours.
