This letter will confirm your reception report of 5 June 1987 from 3:00pm to 3:09pm local time. Your reception report is not the first one we've had from far away places but they are rare. We've had perhaps only five or six since KQAL signed on in 1975. So you do indeed have a rare catch. What makes it even more interesting is that KQAL broadcasts from the bottom of the Mississippi River valley and is surrounded by 500 foot high bluffs on virtually all sides.

We finally got funding from the state last year to move our transmitter to the top of those bluffs and the application is pending with the FCC. We hope to have approval and the project completed sometime this fall.

Thanks very much for the reception report. I am a bit of a DXer myself and enjoy hearing from others like me. We do not have any sort of published coverage map but I have enclosed a copy of the latest program guide.
