
You did it again! Your description of our programming on June 7 of this year is perfect. We've had more than our share of thunderstorms this year, and apparently they did the trick for Dxing.

We changed call letters on our FM as of January 1, 1982. The new calls provide a more regional image for our 110,000 watt signal. We are still operating with the same antenna system, but hope to be on a new tower by 1984. AM-1430 remains KAOL. While we formerly simulcast programming, KAOL now plays contemporary music. KMZU plays country with an emphasis on farm news (as you heard). To answer your question, KAOL will probably be holding P.O.P. tests this summer, but dates have not been set.

Congratulations on your own show. Sounds like fun. As dedicated a radio man as you are, you no doubt put some real time and effort into "Forward March".
