I am Tanya Sherrill, mid-day air personality and sales person for WFXO, the Fox. I am writing to verify that you did, indeed, hear the Fox 104.9. I am the woman you referred to in your letter.

Our location is Iuka (I-YOU-KA), Mississippi. We are located approximately 20 miles south of Tennessee and 5 miles west of Alabama. Our town is named for Chief Iuka who, according to a town legend, is buried just down the street where the Iuka Guaranty Bank now stands.

At 50,000 watts, we are the largest station within about 50 miles. Our format is country. I have sent you a map of our "normal" coverage area and my business card. Please visit Iuka anytime, although I would not suggest July or August when the average daily temperature is 98 degrees. Perhaps you would enjoy late-May when we hold our annual Heritage Day Festival in World Famous Mineral Springs Park. You can also visit Woodall Mountain, the highest point of elevation in the state of Mississippi, located right here in Iuka. And just in case you are wondering, no, our tower is not on that mountain. It is located in a small rural community known as Jacinto.
