
This is verification of your reception of Radio Station WKBB on August 2, 1979.

WKBB is a 3000 watt station with a two bay antenna on a 175 foot tower. This is the first DX report we have received.

You must have heard WROB soon after we went on the air for our first broadcast was either in late September or early October 1947. I believe we did some program test in September but our first official broadcast came in October. Bob McRaney, who signed your report, is still President of the corporation but, has retired from active participation in running our stations.

Our frequency is measured by a local engineer who is able to do it during normal broadcast hours so the only time we are on the air throughout the night is for proof of performance which usually comes during the first quarter of the year or, during special events like elections, we had one this past Tuesday, when we stayed on all night.
