I am writing to confirm your reception of WCQL-FM (95.3) on June 28, 1991. A cross-check of our programming at the time confirms the details of your reception report.

The female DJ you heard was Judy Micheals. She works Saturdays from 10:00am to 3:00pm. The male voice you heard was on a pre-produced promo done by our Morning Man, Bob Meehan. He was promoting the Cool 95.3 Listener Line, one of the many services we provide to our listeners as a way of keeping in touch with us.

WCQL-FM is 6000 watts. We are on the same frequency as WHRB which makes your reception of us that much more impressive. If you want to give it a try at some point, the same programming is simulcast on WCQL-AM at 1380 kHz.

Incidentally, I noticed in your "Broadcasters' Guide to DX" a photocopy of a letter from WQLX/WGLX in Galion, Ohio. That is the station that gave me my first job in radio ten years ago. Your letter indicates that Maumee Valley Broadcasting was the owner of the station. I'm not sure when the ownership change took place, however the station is now owned by Malone Broadcasting. It was a bit of a flashback to see that letter in your flyer.

I've enclosed a station bumper sticker for you. I appreciate hearing from you and if I can answer any further questions, please feel free to contact me.
