
Dear Mr. Cooper:

We have received your report of reception of WGIR-FM on October 20th, 1979. The report you submitted has been checked against our daily program log, and is correct in every detail. We wish to thank you for sending us your reception comments.

WGIR-FM broadcasts in stereo from South Uncanoonuc Mountain in Goffstown, New Hampshire, with 9.6 kW effective radiated power, with antennas 960 feet above average terrain. Our antenna is directional, one of the few FM stations in the country so equipped, to avoid a coverage-area overlap with co-owned WSRS(FM), Worcester, Massachusetts.

WGIR(AM), which you also mentioned in your report, operates with a 4-tower directional antenna system with 5000 watts, daytime; and 1000 watts, nighttime. WGIR and WGIR-FM are members of the Knight Quality Stations group, which also includes WSRS(FM) Worcester, WHEB-AM-FM Portsmouth, WEIM(AM) Fitchburg, and WSAR(AM) Fall River.

I am enclosing a QSL card, and coverage maps for WGIR and WGIR-FM. Again, thanks for you report, and keep listening!
