This letter is in confirmation of your very accurate monitoring report of WSLE on 20 February, 1980. It was a pleasure to hear that we're making it all the way down to the cape from Pack Menadneck Mtn near Peterborough. Our transmitter is a 250 watt Gates which I must keep cut back to 165 watts output and only 140 watts ERP to a circularly polarized less-than-unity gain (-0.237 db) Gates double bay on a 100 ft. tower at 1100' height above average terrane. This winter I've been hiking up the mountain for the weekly remote-metering calibration, at which time I become quite aware of just how high 1100 feet is. Good luck and keep listening.
