This is to confirm your reception on WJRZ-FM on 100.1 MHz on July 19, 1981 between 2:16 AM-EST and 2:47:30 AM-EST.

WJRZ transmits from Manahawkin, New Jersey with 3,000 watts of power from our 340 foot tower located on the shore of Barnegat Bay. We are using a Collins/Rockwell Transmitter.

It was most enjoyable to receive your report from P-Town, as I am a frequent visitor to your town. I recently purchased a co-op apartment in North Truro, just south of your location on the Cape, and expect to visit your area much more frequent.

Your report of reception is the most distant WJRZ was ever received to date. WJRZ started broadcasting commercially on July 4, 1976 at 6:00 AM in celebration of the Bicentennial.
