Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your listener report. Your logging proved to be correct.

Both WLIB-AM and WBLS-FM operate from studios at 801 Second Avenue in New York City.

WLIB broadcasts from its transmitter site located in Lyndhurst, New Jersey. There we have a 10KW Continental 315F transmitter as a main and a 10KW RCA BTA10U1 transmitter as a spare. They feed a 3 tower directional array on 1190 KHz from local sunrise to one hour after sunset.

WBLS broadcasts from its transmitter site located in the Empire State Building. We use a pair of collins 831G-2 transmitters as alternate mains. They are rated at 20KW. Either one can feed the Empire master antenna at the 1220 feet level. WBLS operates on 107.5 MHz at an effective radiated power.
