
Dear Mr. Cooper,

This is to confirm your reception of WIBQ on May 28, 1985 between 3:04 AM and 3:15 AM. You have our format down perfectly and, since the station is automated, we are sure the events occurred at those times. We are quite pleased to hear from you. We don't usually get DX reports on our FM station, so I do not have cards for WIBQ. I am sending you a blank WIBX card, however.

WIBQ first signed on as WIBX-FM in 1948 and went dark in 1953 due to the lack of FM receivers. In 1972, it signed back on at 25,000 watts as WIBQ, and has been on ever since in stereo. We transmit from a 300' self supporting tower on Smith Hill, north of Utica, at an elevation of 1606' ASL. We use a Harris FM10H3 transmitter into a Shiveley 5 bay antenna.

Thank you again for the report. I was pleased to see it on my desk, especially since I had just returned from the Cape, visiting my Dad who lives in Orleans.
