Dear Ernest:

This is to confirm your reception of WLIR on July 18, 1984 between 12:57am and 2:34am, and also on November 24, 1980 between 3:06am and 3:14am (I'm sorry we didn't get back to you the first time). WLIR operates non directional at a height above average terrain of 521 feet and an ERP of 1kw. Back in 1980, we had a different antenna site. 2kw at 380 feet located approx. 5 1/2 miles east of where we are now. We moved it in November 1981. It's present site is on a 34 story building just over the Nassau / Queens border in Queens (where the Grand central parkway intersects with the Cross Island parkway - I mention this only because you lived in Brooklyn and should know where it is). We stay on the air 7 days a week, 24 hours a day. We have an auxiliary transmitter, so we never leave the air for maintenance.

Thanks for your report Ernest, and we hope to here from you again!
