Dear Mr. Cooper:

This letter will confirm your reception of WNCN on May 30, 1980 from 9:48 pm till 10:59 pm. WNCN transmits with an effective radiated power of 5.4 kw horizontal and 3.8 kw vertical at a height of 1220 ft. The transmitter is located on the Empire State Building in New York City along with most of the other FM stations in the city. In addition WNCN utilizes the FM master antenna system on the building as its transmitting antenna. This antenna is used by ten other FM stations in New York including WXLO which you mentioned you also picked up.

I was quite surprised and interested to know that you were able to pick us up in Provincetown since I know that our frequency has quite a few adjacent channel stations which would normally block reception. Again thank you for your reception report. For your information I have enclosed a copy of our June program guide.
