Your letter of October 26 to Jack Miller has been referred to me for action.



I trust that this letter will suffice as official verification that you were tuned in to WCAU/FM on the date and at the time in question.

I'm taking the liberty of sending you Christy Springfield's photo. You might as well have a look at the deejay you heard! And, per your request, I'm sending along a coverage map.

Again, my apology for the delay in verification. I suspect that your first letter is lying somewhere in the dead-letter office, a victim -- as are many other letters -- of the 1985 postal system.
