As for a coverage map of our listening range we do not at present have one, perhaps in the future. I'm just a part timer at WR10-FM, a college station that is mostly staffed by University of Rhode Island students and have been at this station almost a year. Prior to that I have worked at various radio stations WJMF 91.5 and WDOM 91.3 - both College stations in R.I. and also briefly worked for a professional progressive
