I'm replying to your letter of May 17, '89 regarding the spring summer "E-Skips" season, at which time you were able to pick up our signal in your area.

Most of the programming you heard between 12:05 PM and 12:41 PM on Wednesday May 17 was from WFCH 88.5 FM Charleston SC.

The 12:05 mention of Mike Wade with IMS NEWS in Washington was our programming. The 12:10 PM mention of the stock market doings followed by the weather was not our broadcast. It could have been public radio at 88.9.

The 12:12 mention of Sexually Transmitted Diseases, I would imagine was also public radio. The 12:35 mention of the Christian Home and Harold Hall was definitely our material. The 12:35 Bible Reading and the brief news that followed was our station. The 12:39 Mike Wade IMS News was WFCH. The 12:41 The 12:41 WFCH Reports was our program.


This was certainly interesting to me. Provence Town from our transmitter site in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina is quite a distance. We used to spend a lot of time in Oak Bluff on the Vinyard. I never thought the 30 Watt Transmitter could send a signal that far away "E-Skips" or no "E-Skips".

I was very glad to get your letter and call. This sounds like an interesting way for one to keep going in the business. I will enclose one of our program guides as you probably know WFCH is an automated station, one of Family Stations, Inc. network scattered around the U.S.. Our programming originates from our headquarters in Oakland, CA. Normally our coverage is about 60 miles in this flat low country. You may occasionally pick up our short wave station that was purchased by Family Radio originally located in Scituate MA and moved to Okeechobee FL..

This facility uses the same programming, but broadcasts in some ten different languages. It goes around the world.

I appreciate your letter and was glad to hear from you.
