
What you heard was part of a promotional announcement for a contest (see the attached program guide). Actually, the zip code 37132 is that of Middle Tennessee State University -- our licensee.

We are a full-service National Public Radio affiliate. We have been on the air since 1969 -- presently serving the Nashville/Murfreesboro (Arbitron's #30th market) with a music format of jazz and a combination of news from NPR and our own local news staff.

We broadcast with 50 kw from a tower height of 210' above ground. Studios and transmitter are located on the university's campus. At present, we have an application to increase power to 100 kw and move to a tower that is 1,000' above average terrain. This should give us about a four fold coverage area increase!
