Dear Ernest:


It was a surprise to receive your letter regarding reception of our radio signal on May 27, 1990. From the information in your letter, clearly it was KGNZ that you were listening to. This letter is to verify the authenticity of your reception. We would be very interested in any further reports of reception.

To give some background on KGNZ, we started broadcasting on March 9, 1981. We started with an Effective Radiated Power of 3000 watts at 60 ft. HAAT (height above average terrain.) In February of 1986 we were given permission by the F.C.C. to upgrade our facilities. We installed and started operating with 75,000 watts ERP at 700 ft. HAAT on Feb. 22, 1986. Currently we are using an ERI 8 bay polarized antenna with a Harris FM 20H2 transmitter. We also employ an Optimod FM (8100A/1) made by Orban. (This device provides us with consistent modulation.) As you noticed our purpose for broadcasting is eternal. Our format is one of contemporary Christian music with some (few) programs. Enclosed is a Newsletter with a copy of the program guide on the back. Also enclosed is a coverage map. The F.C.C. requires us to provide an estimate as to coverage. Our actual signal reaches more to the north and south than indicated. This is due to the way the 8 bays are mounted on our 400 ft. antenna that is 40 in. in width on its tripod face.

We operate 18 hours a day 6 am - 12 midnight, Monday-Saturday; on Sundays we operate from 7 am - 11 pm. All times are given in Central Standard (Texas participates in DST.)

We hope you enjoyed the brief programming you heard. If you have anymore questions about FM-88 (KGNZ) please call or write.
