
Dear Mr. Cooper:

I am pleased to confirm your reception of WHRV-FM on Tuesday, August 15, 1995 between 12 noon and 1 pm. The interview with Senator D'Amato was part of the Charlie Rose Show. This definitely proves reception as WHRV-FM is the only radio station in the entire Public Radio network authorized to carry the audio of the Charlie Rose PBS-TV program.

Your radio set-up is very impressive. I'm an old DXer from way back and used to occasionally get a QSL card via FM and TV myself, especially this time of year when the ionization layer seems particularly active. I see that you got previous reception verification from Jack Beck and Dwight Davis. Mr. Beck has retired, but Dwight is still our music director.

Finally, I see that you also do classical/band announcing. If you can ever get it, we play symphonic band music every Sunday from 11:30am-12 noon on our other station, WHRO-FM (we are now a rare dual frequency operation). I do the band music program myself, and greatly enjoy doing so. Enclosed is our program guide and a TV coverage map (our radio map is out of print\* and new ones haven't arrived, but our TV transmitter is on the same tower and covers essentially the same turf).
