
WRFK first began broadcasting in 1957 as a 10 watt (12.5 watt ERP) station. We are presently broadcasting with 50 kilowatts at 240 feet above average terrain. We are a non-commercial public radio station affiliated with National Public Radio. Our listening audience is some 45,000 persons which ties us for the number nine position in a 26 station market. We have semi-annual fundraising drives which normally bring in around \$135,000 each time.

I am enclosing a coverage map, an April program guide, and a special May, 1982 program guide celebrating our silver anniversary.
