Dear Mr. Cooper;

This is to confirm and thank you for your reception report of October 30, 1984. We've received reception reports from as far as New Jersey, Utica, N.Y. and Canada before. We only run 830 watts ERP at the present time but we're 2200 feet above average terrain!

At present, our transmitter is located at the top of Killington mountain in Sherburne, Vt. We're using a Wilkinson FM-2500E driven by a Broadcast Electronics FX-30 Exciter. Our antenna is a Shiveley 2-bay which we are diplexing into with the other local station WJJR. At the moment, we are running 600 watts ERP under an STA until we get authority to raise our power up 1150 watts ERP. We expect this to occur before the end of November.

I recently received a letter from a gentleman in Long Island who had also received in the early morning hours when WYNY was off for maintenance.
