Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your letter of June 29, 1988, telling of reception of WIGM-FM 2 days earlier. From what you have logged, I think you must have heard our station, and this letter is a verification of your reception.

This letter of yours is the farthest distance we have received a DX report on our FM. Our AM has been received during DX contests in New Zealand.

We broadcast the same on AM & FM, and the AM has been on the air since 1941, and the FM since 1968. The FM with 3KW dual polarization, and the AM is 1 KW with an antenna 310 feet high. The FM rings are also on the AM tower.

We are most adult contemporary, with polkas in the morning, and rock at night for the kids. We have ABC network and UPI news, and Medford is a town of 4400 population located in the center of Wisconsin.

Thank you for your interest in WIGM radio, and I hope you have continued good luck DXing.
