This letter is to verify your reception of WGBW-FM, Green Bay, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, July 20, 1982. The two programs you heard were the "Performing Arts Profile" and "National Arts Review."

WGBW-FM is a student-operated station located on the UW-Green Bay campus. Our 3,000 watt transmitter and antenna are located on the top floor of the nine-story Library Learning Center overlooking the bay of Green Bay.
