This letter is to verify your reported reception of WACQ, Carrville on the morning of June 11, 1979. What you heard was the required station identification used during equipment testing of a new station.


WACQ is presently awaiting program authority from the FCC. We should receive permission to go on the air by July 1, 1979.

WACQ will operate during daytime hours only. Our tower is 153 ft. in height and our ground system consists of a 24 X 24 ft. copper screen, 120 copper wire radials 220 ft., interspersed with 120 radials 50 ft. WACQ's transmitter is a new Rockwell-Collins 820-D-2. Our power output is 1000 watts non-directional.
