Thank you for your nice letter about your receiving WENNAW on Friday morning Dec 6, 1975.

This was done for two purposes. One a prelude to the yearly "proof of performance tests. Two this transmitter is sort of my baby. It is a 20 year old Gates model BC5P-2, 5KW transmitter, which I have rebuilt over the past year. I wanted to give her a final run before I ran a proof on it.

The proof was very good and distortion was max at 50 cycles at 95% modulation and thm was only 2.8%. Fidelity was flat to 12KC \pm 1.3DB.

I am very happy over this. I have informed the Newark Radio Club that I will take a part in their DX on Dec 22, 1975 from 2:30 - 4:30 AM C.S.T. Maybe you will hear us again, if you do please write. I am returning your stamp to you as sort of a way of saying thanks for letting me know about my transmitter's performance in your area. Also, I received a nice letter from a Mr. Wes Boydin Girard Ohio about the same evening.
