I am writing to inform you of my reception of your radio station on 1150 kilohertz this evening just past 6:30 Central Time. The following are the details of my reception:

- 6:31 A promotional announcement about Z-102. The announcer said "our baby has come of age" and listed goals for 1990 as "to serve you better".
- 6:32 A commercial spot for Buddy's Foodmart.
- 6:33 Recorded Country-Western Music.

During my brief reception your signal was on top of the frequency. It was eventually covered up by several others, including KSAL in Salina, Kansas. My receiver is a Kenwood R-1000 and antenna is a directional altazimuth loop.

If you find this report correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate receiving a brief letter or card of confirmation. I have some 2,400 verifications, including 64 from Alabama. Yours would be a most welcome addition to my collection. I am enclosing a stamp for your reply. Thanks for your time, and the very best in 1990.
